**1) Montreal Joint Rotary Club Visit - May 8-9 (Friday/Saturday): \$83 (Includes: transportation, tip, snacks enroute, guided tour, and lunch at the Montreal Rotary Club.)**

a) Hotel: you will book your own room from a block of reserved rooms. Once you have paid your \$83pp to me (payable to 'Glenville Rotary') I will give you the hotel info to book your room within our block of rooms.

b) Tentative agenda: we'll leave at 7am from the Walmart parking area closest to Hess. We'll drive directly to the border making one stop along the way, and should make it to the Montreal lunch meeting in plenty of time. Itinerary is still in progress, but we will have options: guided tour, casino time, shopping in Old Montreal, night life (Rue de Ste Catherine, etc) **I have reserved a block of rooms at a Holiday Inn. You can use your rewards if you have any!!! \$88/room (not per person; single-quad) (These rooms must be booked by April 10th!!!)**

c) NOTE: Please make sure that everyone is aware that they will have a problem at the border if they have a DWI or DUI (even a 20 year old one), or are severely delinquent in child support payments that have been reported on your driver's license. Using your passport would make your life much easier!

**2) Vermont Winery, Brewery, and 'Cheesery' Tour - June 13 (Saturday): \$50 (Includes: transportation, tip, snacks enroute, admissions where needed, tour of Vermont countryside, and as many wineries, breweries, and 'cheeseries' that time allows.**

a) We will be leaving at 7am, with one rest stop along the way.

b) We plan on stopping at a microbrewery for dinner on the way home. Dinner will be 'on our own' cost wise.

**3) Outlet Shopping / Golf Trip - September 26 - 27 (Saturday/Sunday): \$86 (Includes: transportation, tip, snacks enroute, tour of Amish countryside, 3 outlet malls, and Hershey's Chocolate World on the way home, if time allows.)**

a) Hotel: you will book your own room from a block of reserved rooms. **This is a new Holiday Inn Express within Rockvale Outlet Shopping Center.** (A shopper's dream!!!) Once you have paid your \$86 pp to me (payable to 'Glenville Rotary') I will give you the hotel info to book your room within our block of rooms. **(\$95 per room - single or double; triples or quads may be a slight bit more)**

b) Tentative agenda: we will be leaving at 4am (yes, 4am) from the Walmart parking area closest to Hess. We'll be making one rest stop mid-way, and upon arrival plan to visit the Reading Farmer's Market for ambiance, Amish delicacies, and breakfast before the mall opens. We'll be dropping the golfers off at a course yet to be determined, and then will proceed to Tanger's Outlet Mall (Lancaster, PA) to start our shopping holiday. Early-afternoon, we'll check-in to our hotel located in the center of the Rockvale Square Outlet Mall, and then set you loose to shop 'til you drop. (Dinner will be on our own.) The next morning, we'll enjoy a delicious, included, hot breakfast at the hotel before travelling to Reading, PA to shop the day away. Golfers will be dropped off on the way. If time allows, we'll stop at Hershey's Chocolate World on the way home.
